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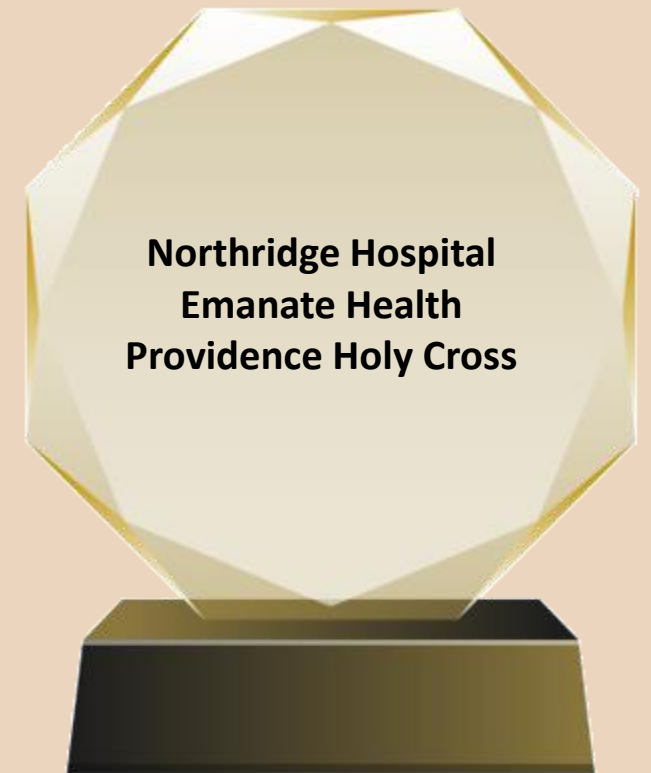
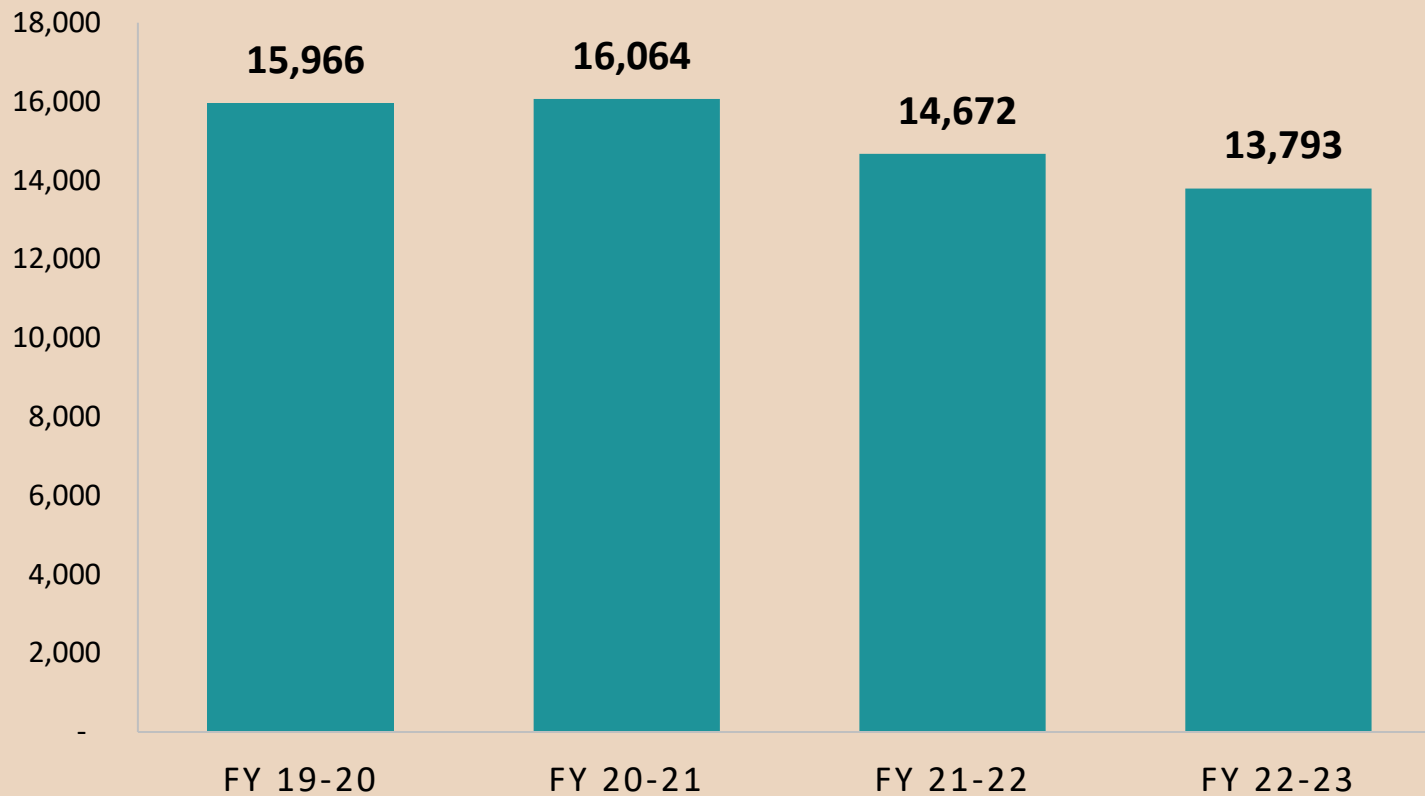

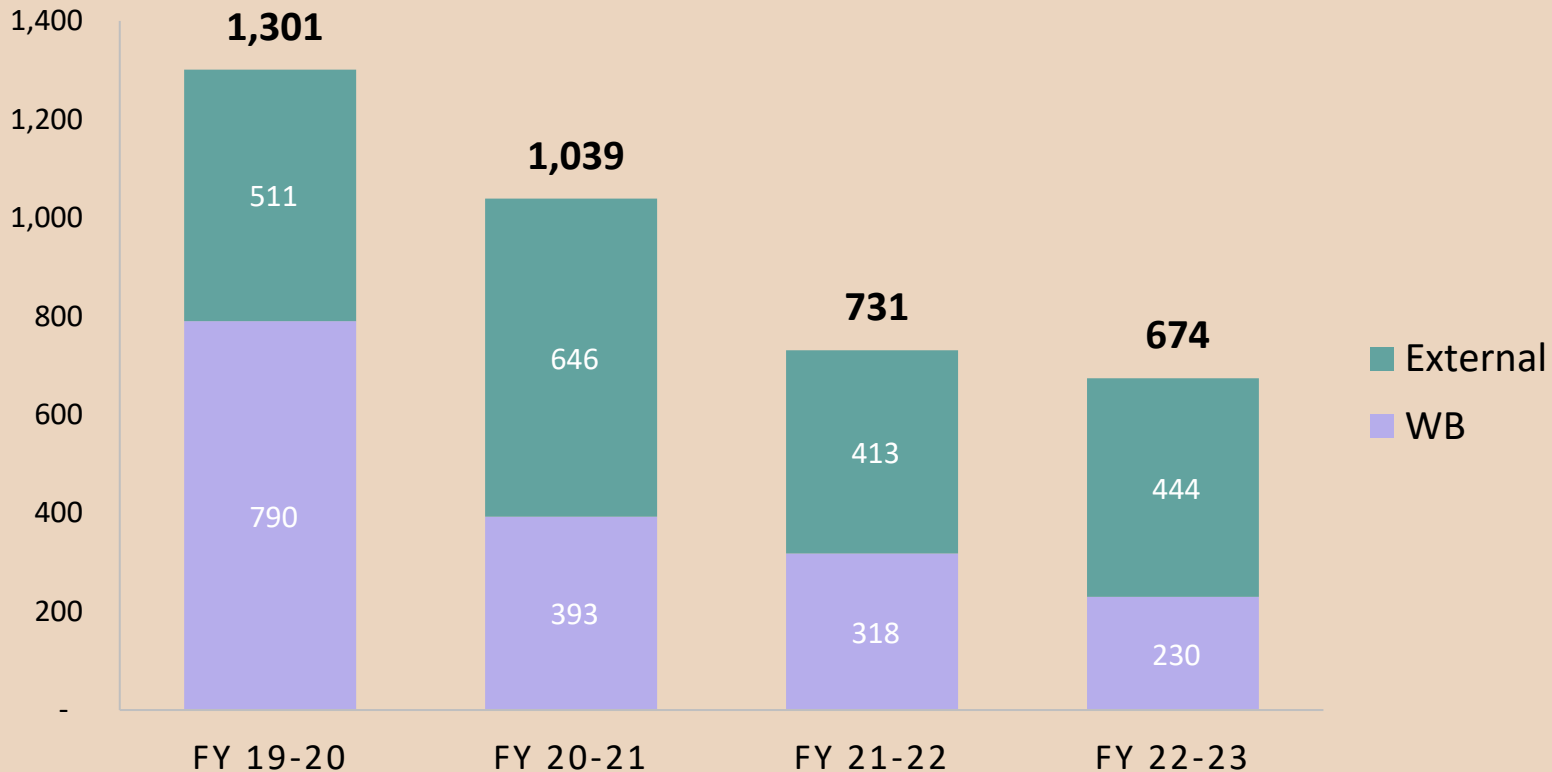

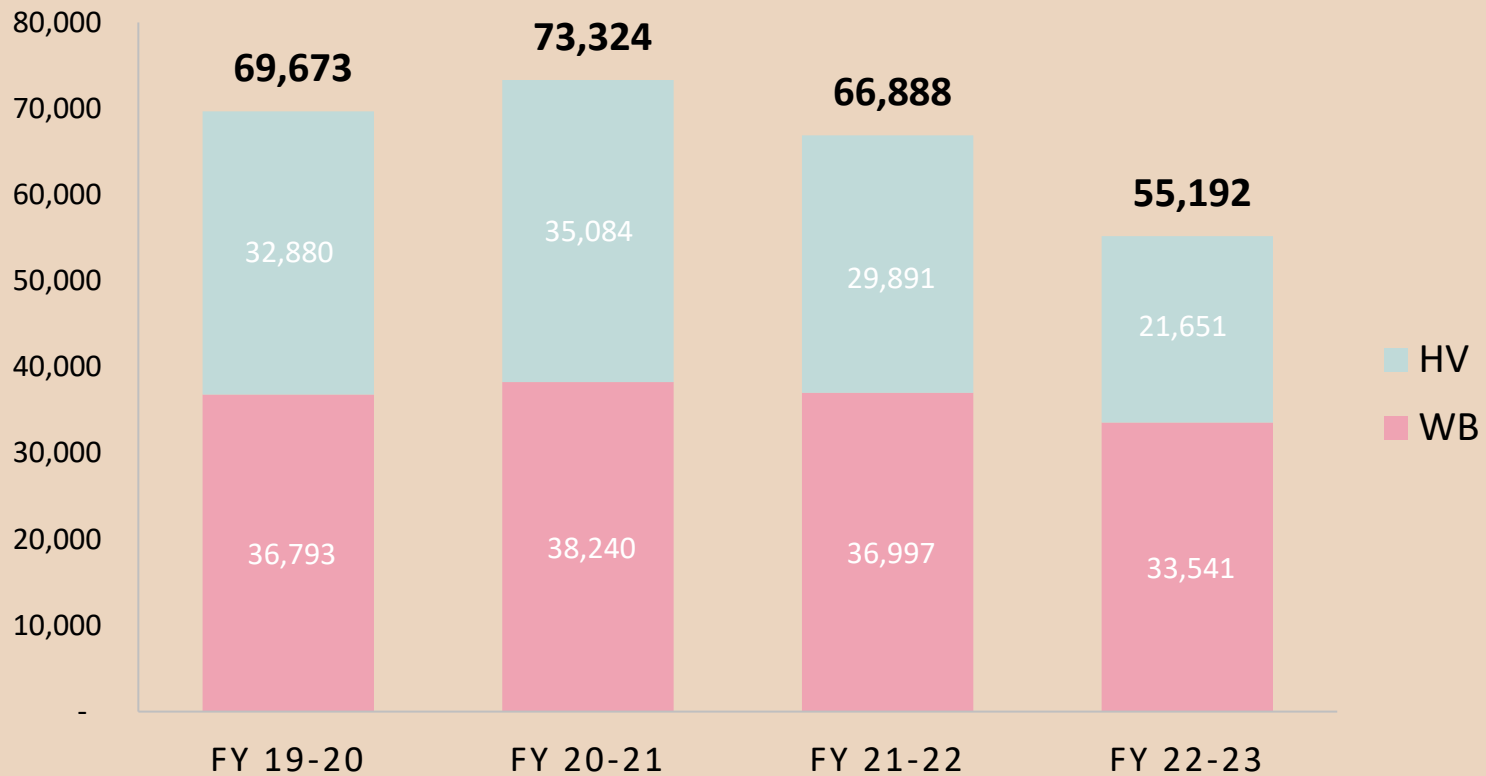

## Home Visitation Postpartum Enrollments

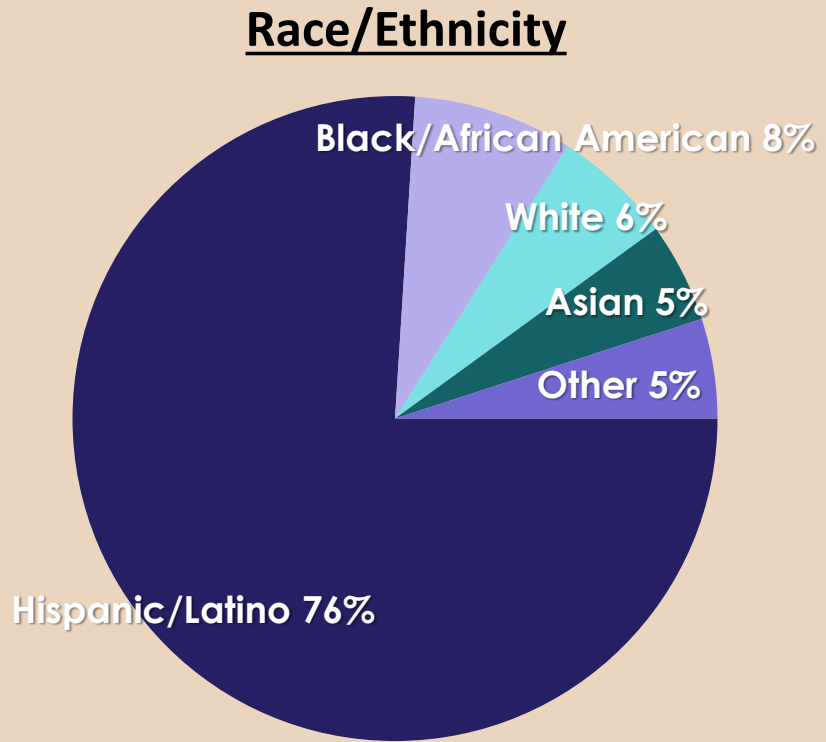


# Families Served – Completed Visits

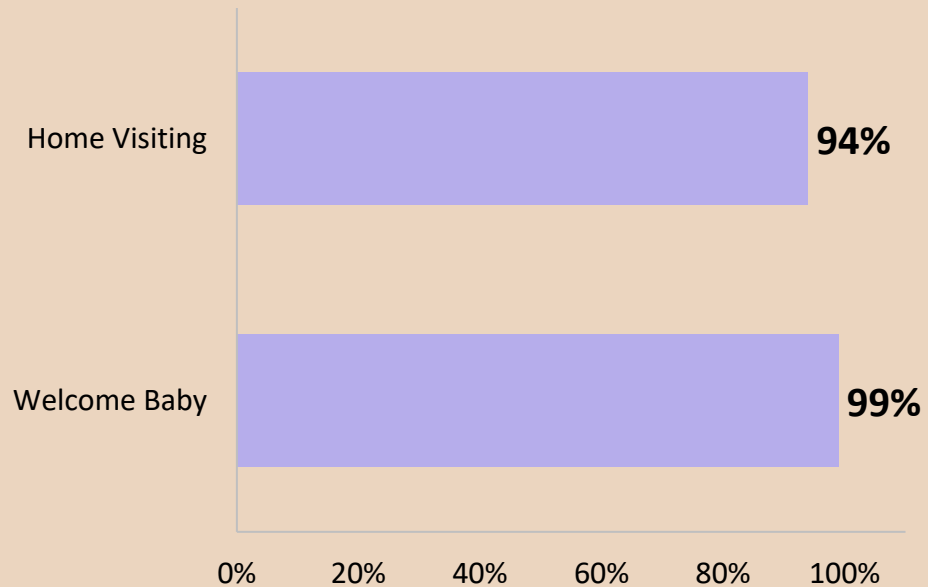

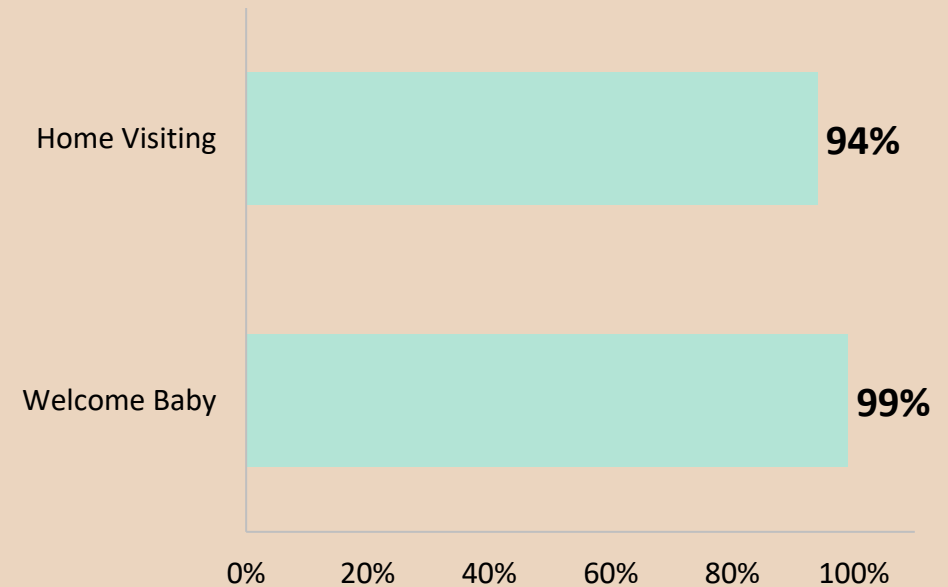


## Percentage of caregivers who were screened for depression

### Within 3 months of childbirth

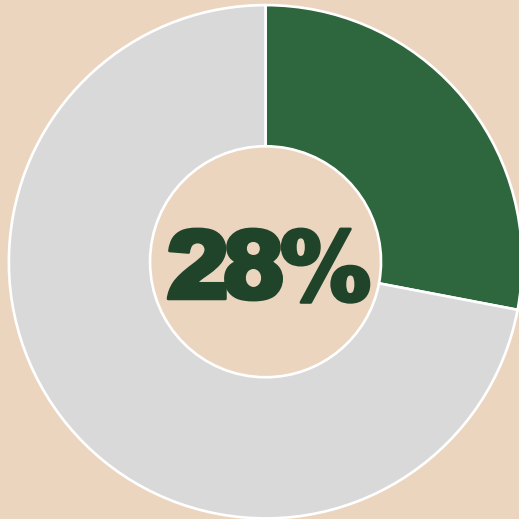


# Program Impact – Child Development Screening

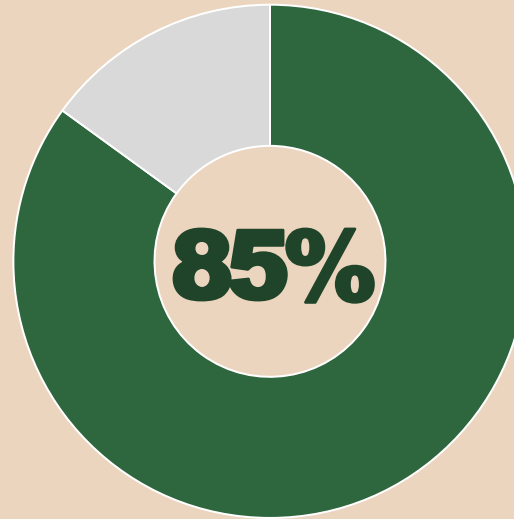


Percentage of children who received at least 1 developmental screening in the past year

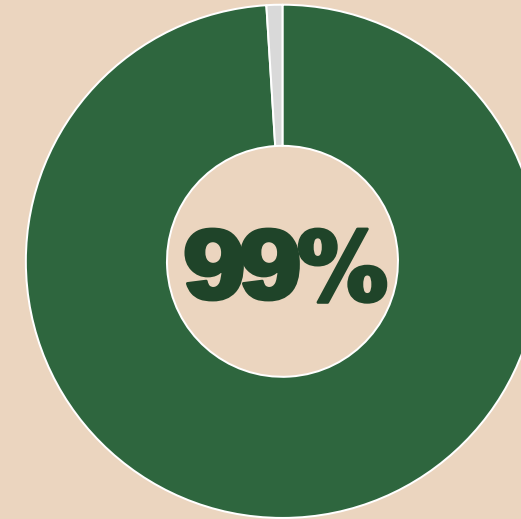

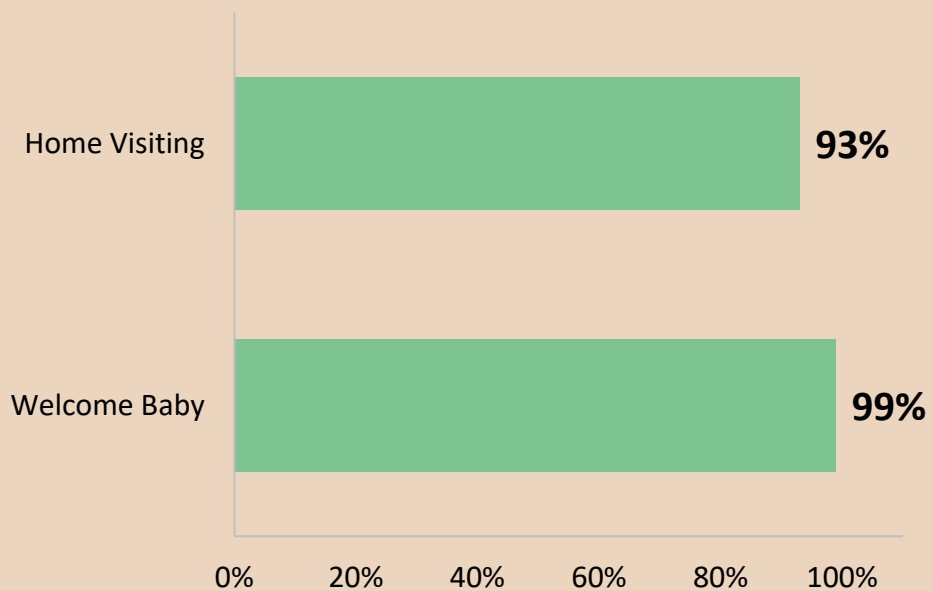

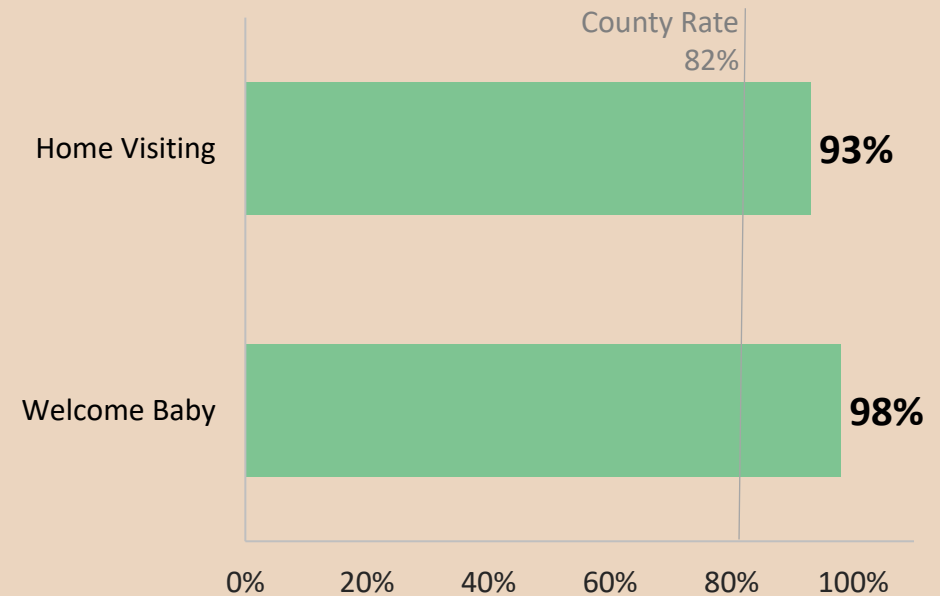
# Program Impact – Safe Sleeping at 2 Months



## Safe sleep education provided

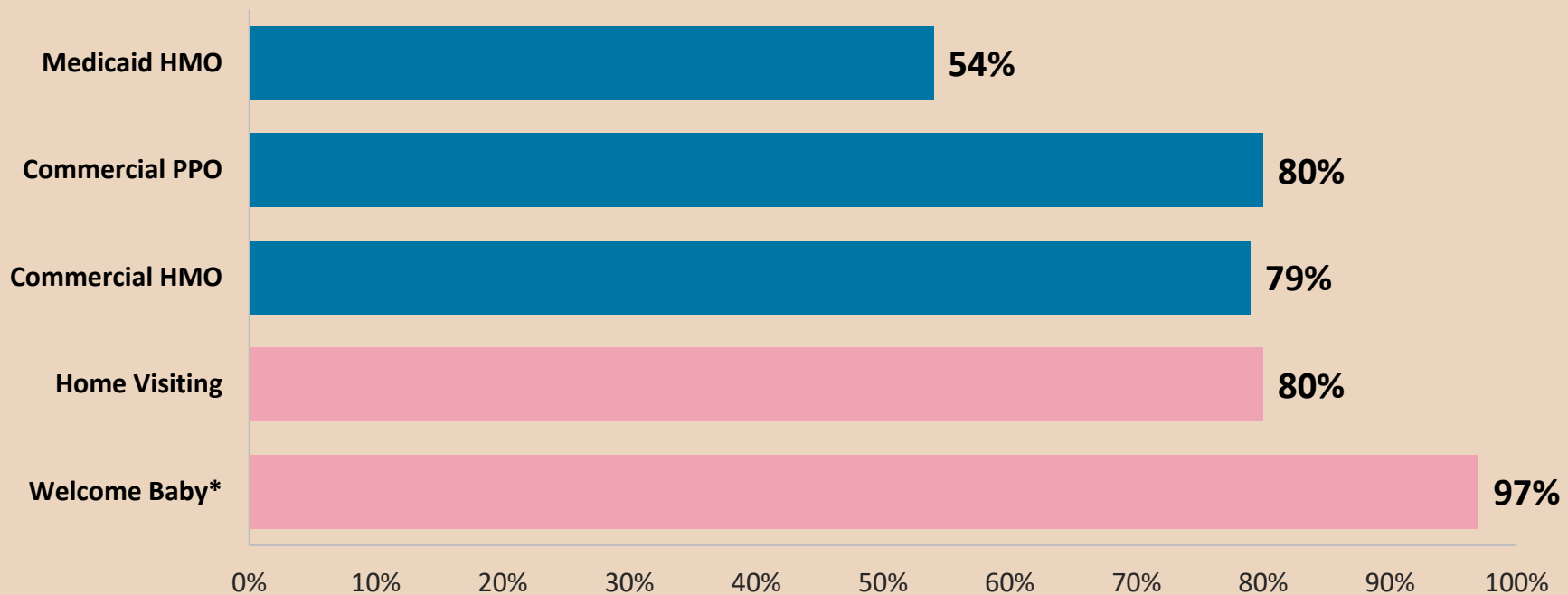

# Program Impact – Well Child Visits

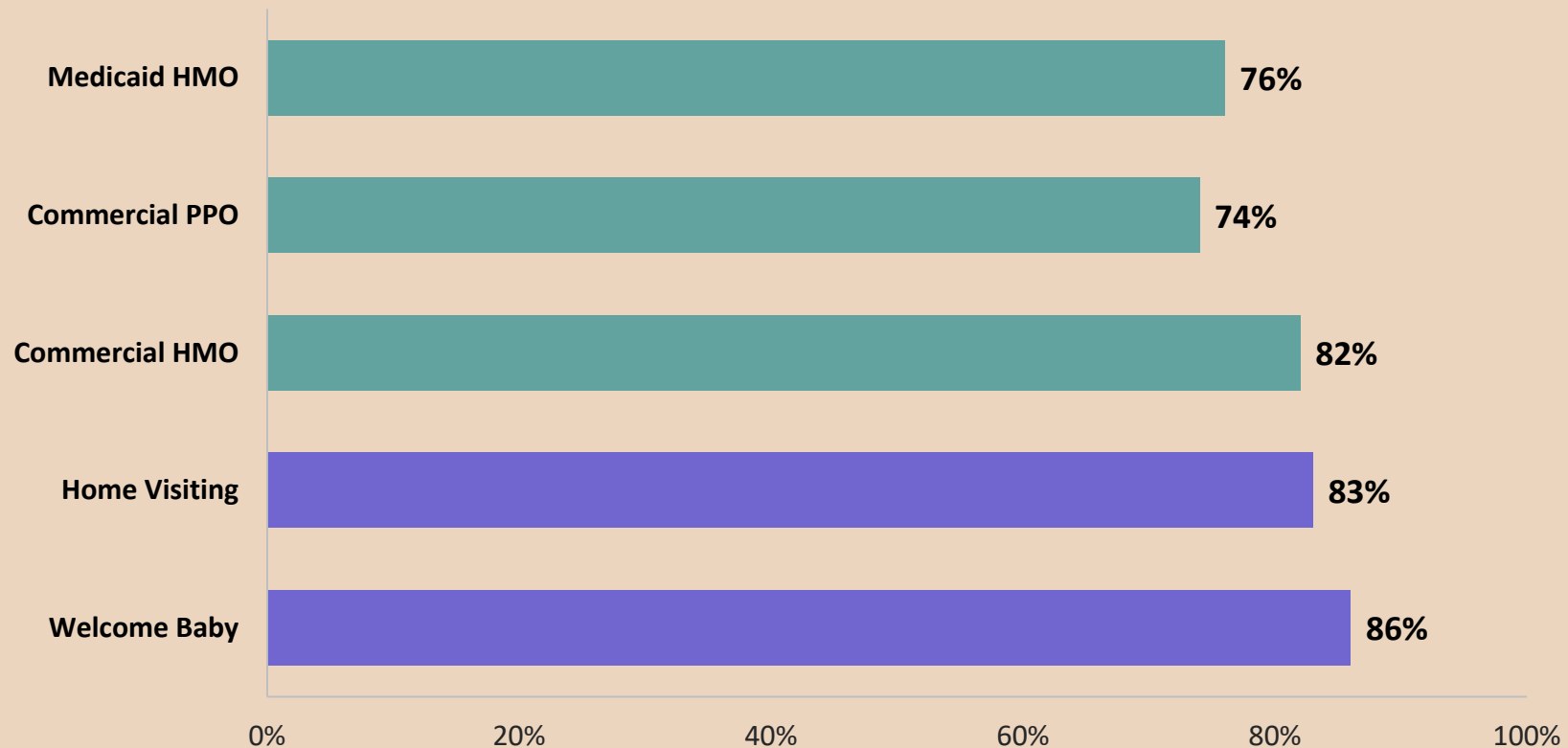
**Per HEDIS, percentage of children who had 6 Well Child Check-Up Visits by 15 months**

**Per HEDIS, percentage of new mothers who had a 6-8 week postpartum visit with a healthcare provider**








# Program Impact – Story: Community Referrals

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**At SHIELDS HFA, a family of 6 children were at risk of needing to move if rent was not paid. The Family Support Specialist supported the family with creating a monthly budget and applying for a rental assistance program. The rental assistance was approved, and this allowed for the two past months of rent to be paid off. The family was able to stay in their home.**

# Program Impact – Story about Goals

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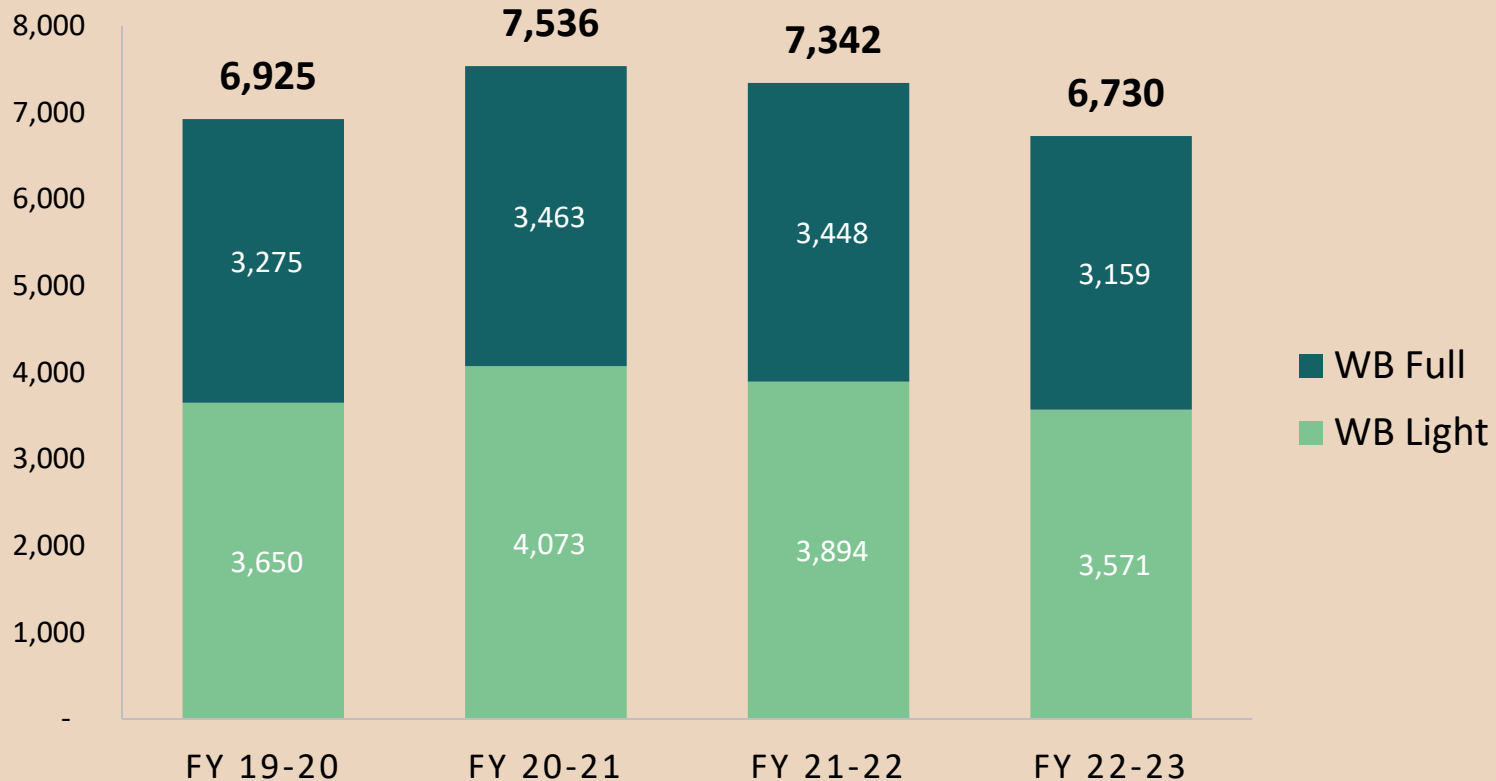
**The family set a goal to work on college applications for an older sibling in the family. The home visitor supported the family with the application process. The family called the home visitor to thank them for the support, and to share the news that their child was accepted to 7 out of the 9 schools they applied to.**
