COURSE DESCRIPTION

The Problem-Solving intervention is a person-centered, strengths-based, housing focused approach that encourages organic and empowering conversations at all facets of the homeless services system. Best of all, anyone in Los Angeles can utilize the problem-solving intervention to assist fellow Angelean neighbors identify housing outcomes. Instead of waitlists and referrals, this humanistic approach helps resolve housing crisis more immediately by utilizing the households existing social supports and resources.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

- 1. Understand the principles of the Problem-Solving intervention.
- 2. Implement the Problem-Solving intervention with households daily.
- **3.** Identify quick and creative housing solutions.
- **4.** Become familiar with problem solving assistance funds and how to access them.

This training is open to community organizations, non-profits, faith-based orgs, and elected office staff who are not contracted by LAHSA but have frequent contact with folks experiencing housing crisis in LA County.
