Home Visiting Day in L.A. County #HVDayLA







Background

Home Visiting Day is an annual event highlighting the importance of free in-home, voluntary early childhood education and support services. The designation publicly celebrates the positive impact and life-long benefits that children and families receive from home visiting programs, and recognizes the dedication of trained home visitors for the critical support they provide every day.



Timeline



2022: The first-ever Home Visiting Day celebration takes place on April 8th with a Home Visiting 101 Webinar and a first-ever L.A County Board of Supervisors proclamation sponsored by Supervisor Solis passes unanimously.



2023: Home Visiting Day is officially set to take place on the third Friday of April annually in L.A County.

2024: The third annual Home Visiting Day commences with city proclamations from Lancaster, Palmdale, Long Beach, and Los Angeles for the first time. The third LA County BOS proclamation is sponsored by Supervisor Solis and Supervisor Hahn and gets approved unanimously.
For the first time, HV Day caught the attention of Telemundo 52, a Spanish news outlet in Los Angeles, which aired a story highlighting home visiting services on May 16.
