

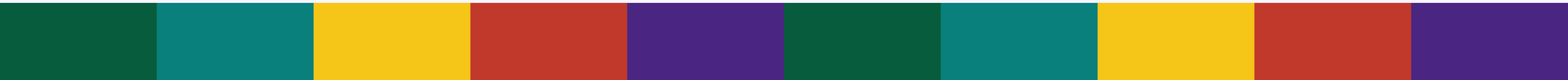

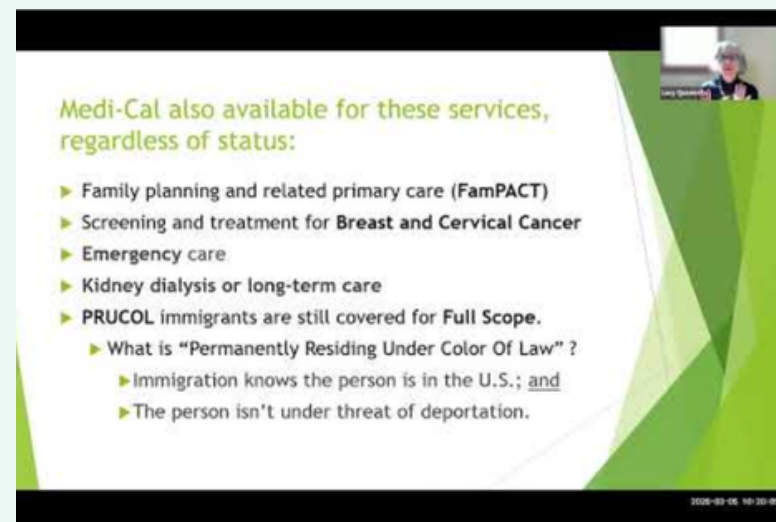

OUR PURPOSE

Coordinate and focus the collective power of member organizations to change systems through narrative shift, policies, funding, and services the center families.



WORKGROUP HIGHLIGHTS



Legislative Tracking

Followed Paid Family Leave, Birthing Care Pathway, Mandated Supporter shift, and Proposition 1.

Planned and executed the annual celebration with broad partner participation.



Advocacy Training

Partnered with Linchpin Strategies for in-person 'Power of Home Visiting Voices' training with over 50 participants joining in-person.



Safety Net Webinar

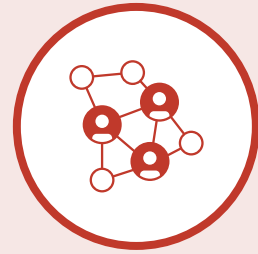
Co-hosted 'Tightening the Safety Net: How State & Fed Cuts Threaten Early Childhood Health' with Multiforum Advocacy Solutions.

Referrals Workgroup



OUR PURPOSE

Support fathers to create wellbeing for themselves and their families through language, practices and policies that intentionally support fathers in home visiting.



WORKGROUP HIGHLIGHTS



Identified Referrals Barriers

Analyzed the Barriers Survey to assess where home visitors have trouble making referrals for their clients, and what they utilize as workarounds when referral pathways aren't working.



Mental Health Resource Panel

Hosted a Mental Health Panel webinar on May 7th with 120 participants joining the webinar. The goal was to partner with mental health agencies and provide home visiting staff with tools, contacts, and strategies to improve mental health referrals and support families in crisis.



Cross-System Partnerships

Invited speakers from several agencies including Early Psychosis Intervention Program (EPI-LA), LAUNCH program at Pacific Clinics, Maternal Mental Health Now, and DMH Family and Community Partnership Program.

Best Practices Workgroup



OUR PURPOSE

Support member organizations, home visiting staff, and service providers to strengthen pathways and linkages for families to the community resources they need and the home visiting program that is the best fit for them, and advocate for systemic improvements to eligibility and access.



WORKGROUP HIGHLIGHTS



Training Survey Published

Published 2026 Annual Training Survey results in May, informing all subsequent webinar topics.



Marijuana & Perinatal Period

Hosted webinar on impacts of parental cannabis usage on development & lactation with 306 participants joining.



Childhood Vaccines

Hosted 'Understanding Childhood Vaccines & Addressing Hesitancy with Care' webinar with 133 participants joining.



Protective Factors

Hosted 'Strengthening Protective Factors Through Home Visiting: A Child Welfare Perspective' webinar with 175 participants joining.



Training Resource Crosswalk

Updated the Crosswalk document to highlight Training Survey needs and existing resources.

Raise consciousness, build trust, and change practices to recruit and support African American home visiting staff and increase African American families in home visiting.

Doula Webinar

Hosted a Medi-Cal Doula Benefit Webinar for home visitors and direct service providers.

Held four Communities of Practice groups for home visiting staff, with four more planned.

Data Report Completed

Completed the data report for FY 24-25 to provide a comprehensive look at the data available from Consortium home visiting models.



Ongoing Data Lake Support

Provided ongoing support and promotion for the Home Visiting Data Lake.



Updated Infographics

Created several infographics from data report findings and updated the Needs vs. Capacity visual to reflect FY 24/25 data.

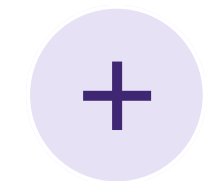
